The Estonian Defence and Security Industry Cluster's overall goal is to enhance the international competitiveness of its 16 member organisations in foreign markets via R&D collaboration among the members and with Estonia's public sector stakeholders.

As a result, the cluster says that both the added-value per employee as well as the sales revenue of its member companies have increased in international markets.

The cluster maintains close contacts with Estonia's Ministries of Defence and Interior to identify and develop dual use capabilities in cybersecurity, electronics, ICT, photonics and robotics for land, naval and maritime use.
